Jackson Elementary School's dedicated staff works as a learning community to help students grow academically and socially. If they do not have what is needed to help a student, they will seek assistance from colleagues within the building, and then the district if needed. They consistently are growing their professional skills through coursework and independent research. Parents have high expectations of our staff to make sure their children achieve high grades and score in the top 25th percentile or better on standardized assessments.

We offer band and orchestra for fifth and sixth graders, and volleyball for girls in fifth and sixth grade. In addition, we have programs like K-Kids, a leadership and service club for fourth to sixth graders, and Peer Mediators, a process in which student mediators help their peers work on problem-solving skills. Each grade level has developed their own unique events, celebrations and special projects that students and parents look forward to when they move from one grade to the next.

Jackson Elementary School has always had a very strong parent group, whose members tirelessly support students and staff. The group's guiding principle is to do whatever it can to support or enrich the opportunities for the most students possible. The Jackson PTO holds successful fundraisers that support classroom expenditures, two annual Book Fairs that generate funds to purchase books for classrooms and a birthday book for every student, monthly family events, special week long reading and family events.
