**Penny War, January 28-March 1.** Students bring in coins to compete with other classes- all for a great cause. This benefits the PTO and a different charity each year.



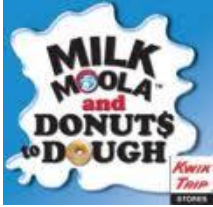
**Culver's Family Night, a Tuesday in April TBD, 4:30-7:30 pm**
